**Matthew 6:9-13** *In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.* (NKJV)

1. Pray with \_\_\_\_\_

*“Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name...”* (Matthew 6:9b)

**Psalms 99:5** *Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his footstool; he is holy.*

**Isaiah 6:2-3** *Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another:  
“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.”*

**Revelation 4:8b** *Day and night they never stop saying: “Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come.”*

2. Pray His \_\_\_\_\_

*“Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”* (Matthew 6:10)

**Matthew 6:33** *“Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.”* (NLT)

**Isaiah 55:9** *“For just as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my ways are higher than your ways and my thoughts higher than your thoughts.”* (NLT)

3. Pray for God’s \_\_\_\_\_

*“Give us this day our daily bread.”* (Matthew 6:11)

**Philippians 4:19** *And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.* (NLT)

**Luke 6:38** *“Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back.”* (NLT)

4. Pray for \_\_\_\_\_

*“And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”* (Matthew 6:12)

**1 John 1:9** *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.*

**Matthew 18:21-22** *Then Peter came to him and asked, “Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?”  
“No, not seven times,” Jesus replied, “but seventy times seven!”* (NLT)

5. Pray for \_\_\_\_\_

*“And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one...”* (Matthew 6:13a)

**Matthew 6:13a** *“And don’t let us yield to temptation, but rescue us from the evil one.”* (NLT)

**John 17:11** *“I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one.”*

**Psalms 91:2** *This I declare about the Lord: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; he is my God, and I trust him.* (NLT)

**Ephesians 6:10-12** *Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.*

6. Pray with \_\_\_\_\_

*“For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.”* (Matthew 6:13b)

**Jeremiah 10:6** *No one is like you, Lord; you are great, and your name is mighty in power.*

**Acts 1:8** *“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”* (NLT)

**2 Corinthians 10:3-5** *For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.*

**James 5:16b** *The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results. (NLT)*
