Matthew 28:18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All power in heaven and on earth is given to me." (NCV)

Mark 10:32b-34 Taking the twelve disciples aside, Jesus once more began to describe everything that was about to happen to him. "Listen, he said, "we're going up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be betrayed to the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. They will sentence him to die and hand him over to the Romans. They will mock him, spit on him, flog him with a whip, and kill him, but after three days he will rise again." (NLT)
Matthew 28:5-6 Then the angel spoke to the women. "Don't be afraid he said. "I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen. Come, see where his body was lying." (NLT)
